A remarkable example of Renaissance architecture at the heart of the Quercy region.

- A model for the study of Renaissance architecture.
- A participatory eco-friendly herb garden.
- Carved decor honouring Galiot, Francis I's master of artillery.

The Château of Assier was built by Galiot de Genouillac, the hero of Marignan, and bears witness to the very beginnings of the Renaissance in the south-west.

Nowadays, only one wing remains yet epitomises some of the finest construction of the time - extravagant, and bearing all the hallmarks of the French Renaissance.

DID YOU KNOW...?

The site is classified as a sanctuary by the French League for the Protection of Birds (LPO) and is home to over 30 protected species, including the barn owl and the kestrel.
